(00:00) live stream with returning guest Charlie Robinson, who is the bestselling author of several acclaimed works, including his latest book, The Octopus of Population Control. He's also the host of the Macroaggressions Podcast, and he's been an MC at the Anarch Pulco uh events. Uh Charlie, it is great to see you. It's been a it's been a minute.

(00:20) How you been? >> Yep. Good. Well, you you and I spoke this summer and I said, "Let's just wait. I've got this book coming out. Well, hang hold off until then. I think it's going to be it's a banger. I think you're going to want to know about it. It's about the past, present, and future of eugenics, the depopulation movement.

(00:38) David Ike was nice enough to write the forward to the book. It's available now on Amazon. It went to number one on the 25th anniversary of September 11th, which is so appropriate. You have no idea. And I hope people will check it out because it's it's 400 pages. It's got 400 quotes from people who had a front row seat to the depopulation agenda.

(01:05) It's all very real and um I do a pretty good job of inserting my dark sense of humor into this uh into this book because the topics are heavy. I mean, you're talking about eugenics. We were talking about mass murder and it is it's not something that you, [clears throat] you know, it's not something warm and fuzzy, but if you're un, you know, if you're pretending like it's not out there, you're going to be doing yourself a disservice because it's there's a very

real agenda.

(01:32) I lay out exactly who's involved in it. And there's two groups that are doing it. Sometimes they work together, sometimes they don't. But, uh, I don't beat around the bush at all. I just straight up name them. like these are the people who are trying to kill you and here's all the evidence and here's the quotes of them saying they're trying to kill you and this is them writing all these documents and these plans where they bullet point all the ways in which they're going to kill you.

(01:56) So yeah, it's it you know it's hanging them with their own words, verbal judo, you know, using the weight and momentum of their own words against them. Like when Kissinger writes a document talking about depopulation, it's hard to deny it, right? It's a declassified document. It's it's it's very real.

(02:14) So that's what I wanted to do. I know people um have real questions about whether this is some sort of like conspiracy theory and I assure you this is conspiracy analysis. You know, this is this is looking at the facts, looking at their documentations, looking at all their all their work and figuring out what the plan is.

(02:38) And the plan is to remove a lot of people from this planet and uh unfortunately they are in a position to actually do it. So I think that's what we'll probably talk about today. It's good to be back. Good to see you. >> Uh likewise. Uh wow, this is uh this is alarming. You know, I'll just preface when I was first introduced to a lot when you I feel like when you when you first are exposed to a lot of these topics, uh it it seems kind of out there where in the back of your mind you're still kind of wondering, okay, am

I just kind of in an echo chamber where I'm
(03:08) just surrounded by people on X or YouTube where they just kind of, >> you know, are sharing the same viewpoint, but there's a lot of holes in it. But then, I mean, at least for me, as I've gone down the proverbial rabbit hole, I've come to the conclusion, no, there's there's actually a lot of merit to this.

(03:24) There there's definitely something there. Uh and you know, we talked about offline too about how people will fighting bigger in the um commentator arena, you know, authorship arena where everyone's got their different take. And I noticed there's a lot of vitriol that goes back and forth. And I've been of the opinion that okay, well, why are people just sitting here fighting? Like at the end of the day, these people are trying to kill you whether it's the Jesuits or the or the, you know, the Zionist leadership or whatever sabotin this or whatever. So,
(03:53) who who are the two groups if if if you could start us off with that? >> Yeah, I'll tell you I'll tell you exactly who they are. So, the first group is what we call the Wasps, the white Anglo-Saxon Protestants, the white devils, right? These are the British. This is the um these are the people who build societies.

(04:12) These are the creators of systems, the enforcers of order. There are the Milner Round Table, the Galton, Huxley, Darwin Crew, Cecil Roads, the Fabians, X Club, Rockefellers, JP Morgan, Carnegie, Ford, Haramman, the Bush family, uh be that Prescott, HW&W, Kissinger, and that whole group. the Enterprise, which is Bush's private CIA, Room 5600, which was Rockefeller's private office, the Vatican, the paperclip Nazis, and the World Economic

Forum.

(04:48) So, you list all those people, you put them on one team, right? Wasp team, right? And what they're doing is since they built the society and they enforce the order and they create the systems, they make calculations about what overpopulation in certain areas does to their multinational business interests. And so they have a vested interest in keeping the population manageable in a place like Bangladesh because if it gets out of control they lose control of the government and it becomes harder for them to manage everything. So their approach is the

(05:29) animal farm and of course this is where you get you know the Orwells and Huxleys and all these guys that write the books about 1984 and Animal Farm and Brave New World and all that. This is that group committee of 300. The the board of directors of the British East India Company is the committee of 300 and as it goes down throughout the generations.

(05:54) So so that that's one group. So they build society but their interest in depopulation is to thin the herd so that the systems continue to work the way they designed them. Okay? It's not great but you understand what they're doing with this, right? These are the ones that use scientific racism to sort of you know they're the colonizers.

(06:14) This was the British East India Company. This was the British Empire. Okay, it was all this the central banking and all that. Then you've got a separate group and these are the Sabatian and Frankus. Okay, these are the destroyers of culture. These are the people who start wars. These are the people who use debt slavery.

(06:34) These are the ones who are involved in actual

slavery. These are the ones that are involved in all the really bad stuff, right? The trafficking of lots of things. These are the Zionists. These are the satanic Jews. This is Habad Lubovich. [snorts] This is the Maxwell Wexner Epstein line. This is the Black Cube of S of Saturn child cult.

(06:56) This is the Greater Israel Project. This is the Kazerian namestealers. These are the Rothschilds. Right? This is that group. and they are the ones who are actively involved in the destabilization of Western Europe and North America through forced immigration and they write openly about that and so I went out and got their plans in which they write openly about that and quoted them in the book so that you can see that it's not like it's not an anti-semitic conspiracy trope whatever to say that the Jews are involved involved in the destabilization

(07:35) of Western Europe. Here is from Ker. People have heard of the Keri plan. Keri was a guy who ran uh the precursor to the EU for 49 years. I mean, he was he was in charge. This is his elevator pitch on what he wants to do with Keri plan. We intend to turn Europe and North America into a mixed mongrel race of Asians and Negroes ruled over by Jews.

(08:06) That's that's not my words. Those are his words, right? He's the one writing the plan. He's the guy in charge. Then you So you go, well, okay, maybe, but like 70 years ago, things have changed. Okay, here's Barb. Barbara Lerner Spectre, Israeli academic, 2010, 16 years ago. Very important. 16 years ago. I think there, by the way, this is on camera. You can go watch the video.

(08:35) I think there is a resurgence of anti-semitism

because at this point in time, Europe has not learned how to be multicultural. And I think we are going to be part of the throws of that transformation which must take place. Europe is not going to be a monolithic society that they once were in the last century.

(08:56) Jews are going to be at the center of that. It's a huge transformation for Europe to make. They are now going into a multicultural mode and Jews will be resented because of our leading role. But without that leading role and without that transformation, Europe will not survive. So it's not me saying it, it's them saying it. Okay? You can find them talking about this stuff if you know where to look.

(09:22) So when we say that the transformation of Western Europe is being done on purpose, I'm not just speculating. They're writing openly about this. And by the way, they've been writing openly about this since 1939 about how what they want to do to Germany and how they want to reimagine that in the aftermath of the war.

(09:40) The war was in the first year. They already had plans for how they were going to divide it into North and South Germany in the aftermath of it. I mean, it's all it's all predetermined, right? So, so I went out and just found all this and and and I think it makes a little bit more sense, right? So, you've got these two groups and they're both actively involved in depopulation and you should be, you know, keeping your eyes on on both of them, but every now and then they come together and they work uh as a team like they did on 911.

(10:12) And that was when you got a pairing of this through a group called Laserkel, which is the circle in

French. It's a it's a been around since the 50s and it's a it started in Europe. branched out into the US in the 60s. And when you take a look at that group, that was the group that did 9/11.

(10:34) You've got the Pac Zionist of the Bushw administration that wrote uh building America, rebuilding America's defenses in in September of 2000, uh saying stating that they needed a catastrophic and catalyzing event like a new Pearl Harbor. That's one section of the group. And then you had the Wasp Neocon retreads from Nixon which was Cheney and Rumsfeld and they were in the George HW Bush Enterprise group.

(11:00) Those two groups came together the Zionist the Pac Zionists and those wasps to pull 911. Okay. So when it benefits them both to have un, you know, never- ending wars in the Middle East and everything that comes along with the military-industrial complex, dropping all their old bombs, buying all the new bombs, dropping all of them again, buying new bombs again.

(11:27) This is so lucrative for both of these groups that from time to time they work together on them, which is what 911 was. So, I think that once people get the book and sort of take a look at, you know, I lay it out pretty, you know, logically. And I think with the hundreds of quotes in there, it it's easy for you to uh to take my voice out of it if you'd like to because it's frankly it's a bit irrelevant.

(11:52) Like, as you read these quotes, it's going to make the case for me because uh it's they it's it's crazy the things that they talk about when they believe that nobody's watching. you know, they'll put it in writing and and you just sometimes have to you just sometimes have to

republish it like I did. So, >> well, you're you're reminding me of what we hear so much about how they have to let you know in advance and I have been sharing with the audience.

(12:19) Again, this is one of the books I have not been able to get to reading yet, but Michael A. Hoffman the second I haven't personally met him. May maybe you have, but his Yeah. Secret Societies and Psychological Warfare. Oh. Um, >> excellent. I I guess this is where that term revelation of the method comes from because people have been saying that I'm like I don't know if you're familiar with that.

(12:37) I'm sure you've met that Victor Hugovaka Jr. guy. He was mentioning revelation of the method. I'm like where did this come from? Why are people I guess this is the where he coined the the phrase but um okay so um out of curiosity um where do where does this kind of Vatican Jesuit element fit into these two groups if at all? Out of curio >> Vatican the the Vatican fits in with the Wasps.

(13:00) there there but but but but again the Vatican bank is not above dealing with a lot of different groups you know what I mean so so there there are some common denominators when it comes to banking right there's a lot of overlap um be when when it comes to media there's a lot of overlap you know everyone says the Jews own the media the wasps own the media the Jews run the media right so so there's a little over overlap there you see that um you know it's it's they are they have mutual interests of course but but the way in which they go

(13:39) about it it's very different and so um and now we're moving into now we're moving into this new fourth industrial revolution that we start talking about this is this

is from the world economic forum we put this on the Wasp category as well and they start talking about the future of transhumanism. And that's a topic that I really kind of hammered home in this book because if you just listen to the sales pitch from Claus Schwab, what he says is that you go through like the first industrial revolution like steam and then you know

(14:17) engines and whatever it goes on to silicon chips and then the the fourth industrial revolution is transhumanism, the blending of man with machine. and you go, "Oh, that sounds like something I'm not interested in." But but I can maybe understand if like you lose your arm in a car accident, you get a robot arm.

(14:37) Or maybe that's what transhumanism means, right? Or maybe it's, you know, you I I don't know, maybe it's just improving the body. Maybe there's nothing nefarious about that at all, right? Um, here's the problem is that in 1957, the British Eugenics Society was having a real problem with their public image because they were involved in mass murder and everybody knew it.

(15:01) So, they wanted to change the term eugenics because it h it was loaded with a lot of heavy uh feelings. And so what Sir Julian Huxley, brother of Aldis Huxley, who wrote Brave New World, uh Julian Huxley, who was the head of of British Eugenic Society, said, "You know what? He wrote a a book and and about something called transhumanism.

(15:26) " And he he [snorts] rebranded eugenics into transhumanism because he thought it sounded more futuristic and and it was a little bit more vague. And so when you hear these guys talking about the fourth

industrial revolution, the blending of man with machine into transhumanism, they're talking about depopulation. (15:47) That's what transhumanism means. It's depopulation. It is eugenics. It is the thinning of the herd. So it's not brain chips to to make you see in the dark or never forget where you left your car keys or something. You know what I mean? Like it's it's not that. they're going to kill you. It means depopulation.

(16:07) That's what it means. That's the definition of it. So, so, so they're casting a spell on you in a sense. You know, they want you to to believe that the word means something that it doesn't. And of course, these guys were involved in writing the books that would uh predictively program the future, the future that we have now.

(16:31) I mean, Brave New World and and 1984 and and Animal Farm were forced down everybody's throat in school as kids, at least in America. It seems like everybody read at least one of them growing up. I mean, they were interesting books, but you suppose like why is that? Why why is it why did everyone seem to have read those books? Or the answer is because those guys were all members of the committee of 300 and this is predictive programming propaganda that they were pushing out.

(17:00) I've written four books. I hope my books get to a point where everybody reads them in school. I doubt that's going to happen, though. Not without without them rigging it in my favor, right? And why would they do that? They wouldn't. They wouldn't. But if you're writing about creating a future in which they seek that they seek to bring about uh a brave new world where everybody's controlled by soma and and and the reproduction is is handled by the

state.

(17:29) Uh then then what you would do is you would write these books and you would pre-program it into people's minds that it could be a possibility. And if you had enough runway like a hundred years like Brave New World came out in 32, you know, you might actually have a Brave New World in reality if you have uh the right sort of backing behind you and the ability to push that narrative.

(17:52) So, um I really I kind of dragged a lot of that stuff out. All those writers, you know, Aldis Huxley and uh uh um George Orwell were in the same French class in the UK. One was a professor, one was a student. What are the chances that the three most transformational books came out of one French class in the UK? Both guys members of the committee of 300.

(18:18) I mean, so this this is how it's, you know, this this is how it's done. When you're tapped to be part of the elite upper class, they uh take your work and make sure that it is spread everywhere and make sure that everybody's sort of indoctrinated into it. So, yeah. So, that's kind of where that's where I started with all this.

(18:43) you you you kind of touched on the time horizons, how it's this kind of, you know, very surreptitious approach to effectuating agendas. Um, you know, a lot of people speculated that they are deriving some value or being aided by um things not of this world. Um, what what has your where have the breadcrumbs led you on that matter? >> Oh, to non-human influence in this.

(19:10) Oh, it's very real. The they're whether it's bloodline, you know, they're very concerned about blood. You know, I learned a while ago that I could be very I

could sort of like my personal stuff could be like, oh god, this sounds, you know, like a little dismissive of it like bloodlines like okay, I guess whatever.

(19:30) But the thing is that it really matters to them and they are they talk openly about working for you know you know non non-human entities things like that. I mean they they they swear themselves to uh things. [snorts] I it's got George Soros here. Like here's an example of some quotes from George Soros. This is just like >> this is in 1993.

(20:00) It is sort of a disease when you consider yourself some kind of god, the creator of everything. But I feel comfortable about it now since I began to live it out and you go, "Oh, well, maybe that was just, you know, he maybe that was just George Soros on a maybe he's drunk, right?" Oh, here he is saying it in 1991.

(20:18) If truth be known, I carried some rather potent messianic fantasies with me from childhood which I felt I had to control, otherwise they might get me into trouble. But when I made my way in the world, I wanted to indulge my fantasies to the extent that I could afford. So I mean, he's George Soros obviously has a problem.

(20:39) He's considering himself a god. And and I think it's important for people to remember not to export their value system onto these people and not say like, oh, I'm I would never do that, so therefore they wouldn't do that. Like they don't think like us. These people are human monsters. Now, whether they're actual like reptoids or whatever, I don't know.

(21:02) But they're they might as well be. They're not human. Not in the way they make decisions or calculations. Um, a lot of them have been, you know, when

you go through this bloodline sort of when you come out of that cult, you're put through the ringer as a as a form of control as a child. So, it's like everybody, nobody gets out of there unscathed, right? Everybody that comes out of this group is messed up.

(21:30) It's not a surprise to me that George Soros thinks he's a god. But I just want to make sure people know that he most definitely does think that he's a god. Right? So, when people are like, "Oh, that guy, he's crazy. He's doing this." Like, for sure. when you go like oh the the Huxley's you know um Aldis Huxley Julian Huxley Thomas Henry Huxley who worked with the Charles Darwin you know I you could just go oh those guys sound crazy no they were literally crazy all of them were in and out of psychiatric hospitals their entire lives there was a

(22:06) third brother who wound up killing himself in a psych hospital they were they were actually nuts So, these are unwell people. These are people who have grown up in the cult, have been traumatized and tortured and put through the ringer, and then they're elevated to positions of power. And so, like, I think it's important for people to remember that that the these are not rational people that want what's best for us.

(22:35) They're they're they're pretty good at pretending like they they do, but they don't. And uh and and I and I have plenty of quotes of them talking about things that are um totally unhinged like I I I have to read this one of my hilarious in fact from Margaret Sanger 1939. This is in a letter to Dr. Clarence Gamble.

(23:01) She didn't get misqued. Um the most successful educational approach to the blacks is through the religious

appeal. We do not want the word to get out that we want to exterminate the black population and the minister is the man who can straighten out that idea if it ever occurs to their more rebellious members.

(23:22) Like uh oh, you know, like so and I get it. It was a different time, but still you're talking about murdering all of them, right? It's it's crazy. So, and and so I, you know, I would go through there and say, well, sure, she wants to exterminate the blacks, but clearly she has no problem with, I don't know, the whites, right? The Irish Catholics.

(23:46) Well, this is what she has to say about them, too. In 1920, the most serious evil of our times is that of encouraging the bringing into the world of large families. The most immoral practice of the day is breeding too many children. The most merciful thing that a large family does to one of its infant members is to kill it. >> Like what the are you talking about Margaret Singer? Are you out of your mind? Like this is And did she put it in a book? It's chapter five.

(24:16) Woman in the New Race 1920. She didn't get hammered at a bar and like, you know, talk to some reporter or something. She put it in a book. I mean, these people are out of their ever loving minds. And and so you have to recognize that they're also the ones that built like Margaret Sanger started the American Eugenic Society which turned into Planned Parenthood.

(24:38) >> 80% of Planned Parenthoods are in the are in the hood. So Planned Parenthoods on Rodeo Drive. You know what I mean? Like this is a eugenics program, a retail eugenics program started by Margaret Sanger who said she wanted infant members to die and she wanted to

exterminate the black population. Like and you you know so like there's some of this has been very normalized in our lives.

(25:05) Like how many people think about that with Planned Parenthood? How many people know that Bill Gates father was the chairman of the board of Planned Parenthood? You know, like this is a depopulation agenda. The the number one the number one killer of black people in America is abortion. It's because Margaret Sanger wanted it that way and the Rockefellers helped finance it.

(25:27) >> Well, they've done a great job of just destroying a lot of the black uh the black community, unfortunately.

>> Uh obviously, uh media being one of them, the drugs, I'm thinking of the CIA introducing crack cocaine in the black community. I mean, they've done all this stuff to just completely I mean, and it's not just the black community, it's all these other communities.

(25:47) You you touch on the the the Irish as well. Um, wow. I mean, again, you know, if your average lay person walking into the street were to hear this, they'd think this is this is out there, but obviously the proof is in the pudding. >> I agree. It's I won't argue with you. You say it sounds crazy. I it it does sound crazy. Doesn't mean it's not true.

(26:07) That's the problem is that you know so when I wrote that my first book the octopus of pop of global control in 2017 I I started to figure out like after pretty much right afterwards I realized that there was a followup to it which was that the running theme through global governance or global government or however you want to define it is that it would be so much easier to pull off if it

wasn't for all these people.

(26:38) And so there's always a bit of a depopulation agenda running through global government. So when I wrote the first book, I noticed that. And so I really wanted to make sure I explored it because this isn't just um you know, it's it it's not speculation. when when you see the the December 10th, 1974 National Security Study Memorandum 200 documents that Kissinger wrote talking about the role of the United States in depopulation around the world.

(27:14) Um they identified 13 countries to immediately start depopulating. India, Bangladesh, Pakistan, Turkey, Egypt, Ethiopia, Nigeria, Indonesia, Philippines, Thailand, Mexico, Colombia and Brazil. and they called them LDC's, lesser developed countries. And then they said, "What we're going to do is we're going to start with these 13 countries first, and we're gonna have a third party cutout, the World Health Organization, do all the dirty work, and then we, the American government, and you, the host country of these 13 these 13 countries,

(27:45) you, the government of these 13 countries, you won't be on the hook at all because what we'll say is that it was the World Health Organiz." So that's what they did. And they started to depopulate and they started to use the World Health Organization and put sterilints in the tetanus vaccines in Kenya and doing that for years and getting busted and and then eventually the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation was formed to carry on this tradition and be another third party cutout and they've been thrown out of India for

(28:16) giving 496,000 children uh non-polio paralysis

from their polio vaccines and um killing thousands more and then paying the required minimum uh amount under Indian law of \$1,000 per dead person or dead kid. Uh so that's the history of the Bill and Meinda Gates Foundation. They're involved in this as well. And this is how they did it.

(28:41) So it was state sanctioned depopulation that was covered up and classified in these documents and once they got declassified now they're in my book. So you can go through and look through and it's not again it's not me writing about this. it's Kissinger and they they explain this is how we're going to do it and then they go out and do it.

(29:00) So, it's not, you know, it we we've got to get honest about it. It's it I mean, what's done is done. This this was happening 50 years ago. But but if if people are in denial that the American Empire is capable of something like this, they need to snap out of it because this has been going on for a long time and they they um they certainly do not feel like there's any line in the sand that they won't cross, especially when it comes to depopulation.

(29:27) So um >> so qu question as it relate okay so it seems like both these sides both the for lack of a better term wasp side uh which is kind of a conglomerate it sounded like from what I got from you and then the sabot and Frank side they're both derived from both of these groups are derived from these bloodline families that I from what I hear from people and I'd love to hear your take that go back to the Middle East and there's this I hear a lot of people talk about Babylon and uh you know these various uh occult

(29:56) practic ices that they've carried over. One of them being trauma based mind control, right? You you you you

uh you you know, you do someone from behind who's five years old by, you know, a bunch of adults, fractures the psyche, then you've got did dis associ disassociative identity disorder. And now you're now you've now you've got different personalities you can tap into. You're easier to control.

(30:19) And by the way, you're also you're a psychopath now because you've been traumatized. And this is basically everyone who's part of these bloodlines. So, in a sense, they're kind of a victim and and the perpetrator. Is that is that kind of what you've gathered? I'm just trying to piece this together. >> Yeah.

(30:35) Yeah. And it's it's it's a little, you know, there's variations depending on what your what your sect is, you know, what your religious component. I mean, if you're in the Sabbath and Frankus, they're doing things differently, but but still, yes, the the the ability to psychologically fracture a small a child, and you know, they they're masters at doing that.

(30:56) This is this is information that they've carried down for a long time. It's how they use it to control people. If you want to be in the cult, there's certain, you know, requirements to being in that. And um and this goes back a long long time. I mean, they're working out some stuff from like Canaanite type you know what I mean? Like this is it's like it goes so far back that it gets very murky.

(31:21) And I tried to stay out of that as much as I could. But I really sort of said um let's let's focus like really on the the the uh the Huxley's the uh Dar Charles Darwin, you know, all of where it came out of this uh evolutionary racism, biological racism, right? So these guys were out

studying birds and they were saying, you know, people are kind of like birds, you know, and they were saying, "What if we classified these people a little bit differently?" and they they started to make the case because they were they wanted to have the justification to depopulate.

(32:02) And so the racial component was always a bit rough. But if they figured if they could come up with a scientific angle to it, then they could say, "Look, it's not it's not race. It's science. It's just science. You know, we have to de we have to get rid of these people because they're genetically inferior, right?" So, so that's kind of where their their angle came for for this was that they were trying to use science as a shield to deflect from criticism of their depopulation agenda which they were carrying out. And so it was just the

(32:32) next iteration of of depopulation. In the old days back with the British East India Company, they didn't even need justification. They would go to India and kill 10 million people, right? they they would just have their private army slaughter them or starve them out or make them grow opium instead of food then export the opium to the Chinese and get them hooked and you know so they were doing all this stuff in but as things evolved and as society got a little bit more buttoned up they felt that they needed to have the

(33:01) justification for their eugenics program and it better be a good one. So they chose science scientific racism and then that became like the the the round table and Cecil roads and all of that stuff and then you know turned into a that but that was definitely coming up through that wasp uh lineage and uh into the into the

Britain and then ultimately the British Empire wherever that expanded to because I did a lot of work on Africa as well and and what Roads was doing down there.

(33:35) He was up to no good down there. >> Yeah, I I uh I'm not intimately familiar with South African history, but if I recall, things were pretty stable there when the Dutch were there. And then I think when Cecil Roads was financed by the Rothschilds, that's when things started to get hairy. And now you have what it is today, which is a hole in many parts.

(33:56) >> Yeah. and and he when he started Rhodesia which is now modernday uh Zimbabwe and Zambia parts of Zambia um it was you know they they came in there and ruled with an iron's fist but this was all part of the this was all part of the scientific racism that they had experienced in India right they I do some work on this in in in the back of the book with with the cultural stuff which is you Well, [clears throat] they weren't wrong about their place in the pecking order in terms of intelligence. Okay, they would when they

(34:34) rolled up into India and places in South Africa and some places in in South Pacific, they were four standard deviations below the norm in terms of IQ, right? The Indians were were essentially cattle to them. So the the racism was kind of baked in because once the British, you know, were colonizing the world, they were, you know, when you when you stroll into Papua New Guinea, take a look at those boys or into Australia and you see the aborigines, you're going, we're not even the same species, you know, like where this is,

(35:12) you know, and so they wiped them out

immediately, colonize them, enslave them, you know, anytime they came across people in there was a massive IQ disparity. They were getting enslaved. Okay. And then the Jews would run the slavery and then sell them off. Okay. So, well, not not just not always the but the British East India Company did a lot of that as well, but but they were it was a uniquely Jewish operation as well uh when it came to the transit transatlantic slave operation.

(35:45) So, that you had the Sabatian and Frank working on that. So again, like their paths cross often, you know, you're you're down there colonizing Africa and you got a lot of people that you can ship elsewhere. Same with India. They're not worth they weren't they weren't shipping the Indians off anywhere.

(36:02) They were just exterminating them. But it was, you know, this this is how it was do this is how it was done. At one point, the British East India Company w was its bit had its own private army. It it it it had its like it be like if am Amazon times a million plus a million Blackwaters. >> It's Avatar.

(36:23) It was like the movie Avatar. >> Yeah. Yeah. >> Right. Where they have a private army. I think the corporation goes and >> Yeah. That's that's that's that's what it was. The British East India Company was bigger than the the crown. I mean it essentially was the crown but they were run and they were run out of the city of London.

(36:41) So they were they were involved in trafficking drugs people and depopulating you know at the same time but but again their their their reasoning for depopulating wasn't because the Indians were subhumans that all needed to go. It was because they needed stability in the

marketplaces. They needed to create their um they needed someone to to grow their drugs for them.

(37:10) They needed to grow the opium for them. They needed people to get involved in the textiles for them. They needed so they needed to get rid of a bunch of people so that they could have control over the area so that they could build systems there that would last for hundreds of years and and they could extract all the resources out of India. So that's what they did.

(37:25) when they were killing people, when they were murdering people, it was more like they were they were just getting rid of everybody that was going to destabilize their future operations. Whereas the other sect, the Sabatian Frankus like to kill for the love of the game, you know, for for their guy in the their imaginary man in the sky who demands it and things like that.

(37:52) So dark So, uh, I want to hear your take on that on their imaginary person in the sky and I want I want to hear I'd like to hear your take on Saturn because that's something that is really fascinating you to me and I and I'd like to learn more about. But real quick, I do think it's interesting how the East Indian company, you have messages of it in the uh, you know, American flag, you know, like especially the the the colonies and then the Australian flag and all these other former Commonwealth nations, if you will. um you you have messages of that

(38:20) uh private entity, you know, it's just interesting. It's still visible today. >> It's you know, it's funny because it it never went away really. It just sort of transformed. You see it also in um you know, the British Empire, everyone says, "Well, the British Empire went away mostly like in

the 1950s after the, you know, there was a war that sort of didn't didn't really go their way.

(38:47) " And it felt like the British Empire kind of broke apart. Well, really it became more of offshore banking colonies. You know, that that really was how it pulled back into the city of London. I sort of describe the the octopus of population control. You know, most a real octopus has three hearts. >> Really three hearts. Yeah.

(39:09) as the Vatican, the city of London and Washington DC and uh pumping fiat currency through the veins of the the whole system, you know, that that's been effective at keeping everything going. You know, I don't know how I don't know how much of the British colony actually went away. I don't know how much of it found its way into Washington DC at some point.

(39:32) Because a lot of this what what I I mention in here when it gets into like Cecil Roads, Road Scholarship, um Cadam House, Royal Institute for International Affair, Council on Foreign Relations, these groups were set up by the British Roundt to in some ways destabilize America so that from inside like with with road scholars who are like they're like time bombs sent to destroy America like Bill Clinton and Rachel Matto and I list a bunch of them in the book. That's Cecil Roads.

(40:06) He wanted to destroy America from the inside and fold it back into the British Empire. And that's why he they financed all these things. That's why that's why the Council on Foreign Relations exists. It's a sister spin-off of Royal Institute of International Affairs, which is started by the British Roundtable Group.

(40:24) So th this is what they're doing. They're trying to

um so even within the faction there's still infighting even within that Wasp faction which is like the British and the the northeastern uh eastern money trust of of like Boston, New York, Philly, Jersey, you know that that whole area in there. Even though they're sort of on the same team, they're still in fighting there.

(40:48) The British still haven't given up on getting America back. I I don't know if they want it anymore, but and I don't know if they're in a position to even ask for it anymore. They've really kind of destroyed themselves. But at least the the old timey roundt guys, they wanted America back. They were personally offended by that whole thing.

(41:05) So, so they were trying to destroy it from within with some of these uh groups that they founded. And now these groups are so normalized that no nobody if if anybody even knows what the CFR is, they certainly just assume it's some globalist deep state group designed for world government and to benefit the American Empire.

(41:26) Little do they know it's actually designed to destroy the American Empire. But again, it doesn't, you know, shouldn't be surprising to anybody. >> Well, I think they've done a great job of destroying things. you know, when I when I get when I go to the house, when I um you know, I'm just out and about and I don't I don't go out a whole lot.

(41:44) Um I usually my outing is just kind of going to the gym and uh maybe go to the grocery store and that's really about what Christian Mike does on a daily basis. That's about it. But when I do go out there, I do see what I what I'm hearing and seeing about and I suspect that a lot of

people where they're not aware of this, they're they're completely bereft of why things the way they are, you know.

(42:07) Um, I'm not knocking people with blue hair, but I'm just, you know, when I when I see people with, you know, blue hair and and and rocking, you know, a lot, you know, all these rings on their nose and and just covering their face up with with with with, you know, artwork.

Again, I'm not not coming from a place of judgment.

(42:20) I'm just coming from a place of that's been done by design, coupled with the music, coupled with the media. And, you know, I've talked about adnauseum as as we all have observed. I mean, nobody's getting married, nobody dates, people aren't having kids. um you know, mental health stuff galore. How many people are on pharmaceuticals? I go to the gym, I look up and it's propaganda from CNN, propaganda from Fox News, and then it's pharmaceutical.

(42:46) If you're struggling with weight, take this quick fix.
>> Yeah. >> You know, there's never, right, there's never any talk of, okay, let's let's tweak your diet or your mental health. Let's tweak this. Anyhow, um so yeah, they've done I think they've done a complete uh they've done a great job of destroying a lot.

(43:02) Um, wanted to touch back on Saturn, the cube. Uh, people talk about like the Muslims going around of the circle and then some of the Jews had the the black and then Trump and then there's I guess a black cube in Irvine, California and you've got in different parts and Trump Tower is another one and >> and so where where I mean where has the where have the breadcrumbs led you? How

does that all impact their their God if you will? And >> symbolism will be their downfall.

(43:29) They love they they communicate with symbols. It's important to them. Uh you can see their work everywhere. They're hung up on Saturn. It's a big deal to them. Remember going to the the new World One World Trade Center and they've got like a they've got like a water feature out front fountain that I just took one look at it go like black cube of Saturn.

(43:55) Of course, nobody around me. I I could never say that to anybody in my family. They would not understand what I'm going for. But um I see it everywhere now. And and this this goes back to their these ancient beliefs of them and they they're you know that they believe that they're driven by something else, right? They they they have a much different view of the world.

(44:22) It's easy to be like it's it was easy for me to be dismissive of it and go like I mean, okay, what sounds stupid to me, but whatever. But they get it. It it it matters so much to them, their their symbols, their hand gestures, their outward uh shows of obedience to the cult that you you could be dismissive of it, but you do so at your own peril.

(44:49) I mean, they're trying to signal to people what is going on. And it gets back to, as you mentioned earlier, like revelation of the method. I mean, they're they're explaining uh you know, when you see everybody with the with the bruised left eye, that's not accidental. I mean, it's not they're not slipping and hitting their face on a coffee table.

(45:10) This is being done as part of rituals, >> which I

think, >> well, sorry. Which I find crazy because if you're if you're a Prince Phillip or if you're all these highle people and you're getting how how are how is anyone able to get that in close proximity to you? A and B to be able to do that. I am nowhere near these people and I have never had a black eye.

(45:27) >> Yeah. >> So So that that's that's that's a red flag. >> You've never had a parasite placed on your eyeball before. >> Oh Is that what it's >> that's what does it?

That's what does it that's what they're inserting into their eye and that's what gives them the black eye. Yeah. That's and and the as the story goes, that's when they get taken over at that point where they're no longer sort of in control of themselves, sort of like detached and something else is taking over them.

(46:03) But you'll see you'll see the black eye club. They're all they're all part of it. I mean, this this is this is the stuff, you know, I get into a bit of this in secret societies and we we talk about some of the rituals. We talk about skull and bones in there. It's it's a you know it's it's important to to know that this is out there. Not dwell on it.

(46:23) You know, you don't have to like it doesn't have to freak you out, but but it is I think it I think we need to recognize that these these groups out there exist. They have a plan. They have an agenda. This is what they want to do. And um and it's very real, but it it sounds crazy. And so it's tough to get people to take it seriously because it sounds so crazy.

(46:48) But then something will happen in your life and you'll go, "Man, I swear to God, I think they're trying to kill us." And you go, "Yeah, they are. Yeah. Yeah. That's why

it's like, oh, there's all this poison in our food. It feels like they're trying to kill us." Yes, correct. They are trying to kill you. Trying to poison you with the food.

(47:04) Trying to poison you with vaccines. They're spraying chemicals in the air. Not theoretical. I've got a whole John Brennan quote in the book of him sitting in front of a television camera and microphone talking about the CIA's aerosol atmospheric injection program chemtrails. So I mean again this is all conspiracy theory unhinged nonsense.

(47:32) No it's not the head of the CIA admitting to it saying yeah we've been doing it for a while. So, >> have you had Dane Wigington on? I'm sure you have. >> I I have not had Dane Wigington on, but I know who he is, and I think Yeah. >> Okay. So, I'm I'm I'm planning to have him on. He He gave me a homework assignment to uh watch his documentary, and I was hoping to save that for for a trip where I could just, you know, watch it in the car or listen to it.

(47:59) But um uh so I I'll have to introduce you to him. I met him through Katherine Edwards. >> Um because he's he is as far as I'm aware the the like the authority more or less on that topic. >> Oh yeah. >> Um >> um what was I going to mention? Yeah. Uh okay. So back to Okay. So So Saturn, how about black goo? You know, I've heard some people talk about black goo.

(48:19) Have you gone down that? >> I've heard I I've heard about it. And of course I've seen Prometheus. If you ever watch that movie, they drink black goo or he the guys like drink this thing and explode all over the place. Yeah, it's a I I don't it I don't I I know that there's some I I know

that there's something there, but I don't know enough to know how it all works or >> or what it's coming from.

(48:49) But they're they're signaling a little bit about that in movies through time. They've been again they could have picked any color for the goo, but it's always the black goo. >> Mhm. >> Yeah. >> Yeah. They they put you a lot in a lot of uh uh entertainment videos, music, which again, I'm just appalled when I see some of the stuff that comes out.

(49:09) >> Oh, yeah. >> You know, I I uh I see some of the music videos. I'm I I straight up like I'm not just talking about gangster raps. I'm talking about like just straight up like transgender just I'm just like what the am I seeing right now >> and you're getting millions and millions of views and if you want to talk about truth you'll be absolutely crushed in the ratings and so it's just crazy how inverted how satanic it is.

(49:37) I just can't believe this and these people are rewarded. >> Yeah. Well, I put I put this in the the the final tentacle I I I focus on is cultural. And I talk about Yuri Bzmanov's demoralization, you know, and and this is there's there's a four-step plan for demoralization. And you can it takes about 25 years to run through a cycle, but he's explaining this to G.

(50:00) Edward Griffin in the early 1980s or late 70s. You know, I think we had enough time to run this cycle twice. And it it requires a six-w week crisis as step three. And then the fourth step is normalization. And it feels like COVID was that crisis. And and we're in the normalization period of the demoralization process where they're saying everything was fine.

(50:25) We were always at war with Eurasia. We were always, you know, you were all we always wore the mask. We always took the shots. we always so this is the the normalization process of of what Yuri was was talking about and part of that is like normalizing transgenderism and normalizing 12 perversions and and normalizing you know Tom Delay a guy who was a he was a guy for like a say he was like the house Republican whip or something something like that he's went on C-SPAN back in 2015 and then again on 16 and said, "I got out of a meeting at the Justice

(51:04) Department where they were talking about normalizing 12 perversions, including pedophilia and bestiality." And the host was like, "What?" [laughter] Like, "What are you talking about?" He's like, "I just got out of a meeting where they're trying to normalize that." Like, okay.

(51:26) And then he said it again in 2016 and and I I remember watching that those interviews in like 2018 or something going I bet he's on to something like I wouldn't be surprised if he and look where we are now. They're they're now it's I just saw something that they were talking about normalizing bestiality in like some sort of congressional thing.

(51:46) I was like Tom Delay was 100% right. It just it takes 10 years and and then you can you can do that. That's what I I get into in this cultural tentacle. Like you would be you would be terrified to know that they can depopulate you and make it be your idea, right? And they certainly have. They've changed the culture with so many uh you know, they've made it so unappealing for people to

have families and to feel like they can financially afford that. That's all done by design.

(52:17) It's it's a it's a perfect depopulation agenda. It costs them very little. It's impossible for people to quantify. Can't blame them really. It's hard to blame anybody for it. (52:36) So it's there's you know sometimes it's subtle. Changing the culture, changing the way people think, changing what's cool, you know, it's not families aren't cool anymore. Uh be a be a dirty you know, do all this. freeze your eggs. I put a big thing on there. All the corporations that are encouraging women to freeze their eggs and be a girl boss and stay in the workforce till they're 50 and then try and get pregnant and all that stuff.

(53:01) Like that's part of an anti-fertility agenda. It's most definitely happening. It's measurable and I've got all the receipts for it. So, you know, I think that people are you that's the the most alarming part of the book is that it's coming from every angle and you're you can't be immune to it. You just have to be aware of it because they're they're, you know, they're getting you in your food and your water and everything else.

(53:23) And I don't mean this to be like black pilling or anything like that. I I say it to just be cognizant that we're at a war and that they're trying to kill us and that you need to be aware of that because if you think that the government is out to is like your dad or something, you're going to have problems moving forward.

(53:45) You need to get straight about something. Your

government hates your guts and wants you dead. Okay, know that, live it, understand it. You know, like Brad Hamilton said, >> you know, you know what's so interesting is is they've done a great job of portraying people that were anti-government as being wackos or cuckoo. And I see the light now.

(54:08) I recognize that the government, they are the enemy. Uh, and people get caught up, as I share a lot on the show, people get caught up on, oh, they arrested this person or this cartel and it's like, you know, putting a band-aid on something. The root cause that the head of the snake is is the government and is and are these bloodline families that control the the the government, the the shadow the real the shadow government, for lack of a better term.

(54:35) And so, um, yeah, they have done a uh they've done a really stellar job. I'm trying to think of what else I was going to comment on um this is tangential, but you you mentioned about someone freezing their age. You know, I when I this was when I was living in in in Newport actually. Um one of uh one of my friends I'm connected with.

(54:52) She's probably in her 60s. Um very well connected over over there has done real well for herself. But she's like, "Hey, I want to I want you to go on a date with so and so. I think she'd be awesome." And I think she was maybe just like a year older than me or whatever. But she's actually originally from South Africa. uh and like no acts or anything very Americanized.

(55:09) So I don't know maybe she left at early age but she was an attorney and um and talked about yeah free

freezing her eggs and and all that stuff but I just kind of got that boss babe sort of vibe >> and I never heard from her again nor do I have any interest. This was uh probably three years ago but I just thought I'd share that that um there there is a lot of that out there.

(55:30) Um, I have a family member who is, you know, in in in her 20s and, you know, she's she she's a CPA, but there doesn't appear to be any interest in um, you know, looking into having a family. I mean, I've never I've never approached that. Um, but you you you see how they have inculcated so many people and a lot of men candidly, I know we're deviating here for a moment, but a lot of men have have just completely checked out of wanting to date.

(56:02) I mean, because of why do I want to invite the government in if it doesn't work out? Do you want to enter a And and I I love the women in my life, so I'm not knocking the women in my lives. Women out there. A quarter of the audience is is female, actually. Um, what I'm getting at is, you know, do you enter in a contract where one party could be rewarded for the dissolution of it, right? And so, >> having known people who've been destroyed um, financially and and and and some people who are just Yeah, there was one guy knew it happened to his his

(56:33) brother and again, I don't know what the brother did, but you know, there was a there was a divorce and never the same person again. Just completely withdrawn, checked out. So men men of all ages apart from the younger generation I I I think are are are genuinely struggling. >> And Gloria Steinum died last week and she was the founder of the feminist movement and she was a CIA asset and she >> I'm not surprised >> she'd been

working with them.

(56:59) That was the reason why she was there. Her job was to >> was to uh you know get women into the workforce, get them onto the tax roles, get them out of the house so that the kids could be programmed. This was a Rockefeller initiative. I mean, the CIA was behind this. This was this was not accidental.

(57:16) It wasn't all women's empowerment. That's the thing is they sell it. They're great at narrative management. I mean, they sell these stories to people and they convince them that this is female empowerment, but it's it's it's coming from the CIA. You know, it's not it's not what you think it is. It's not even, you know, stuff like the summer of love.

(57:34) You go back in 1969, hate Ashberry and all that stuff. It's a CIA operation. like all of this the culture the culture changers you know the people that are there they're they're there's always some external influence on that on these these uh these real important events these uh pivotal times or places you'll always find the intelligence agencies in there trying to direct it you know make either make it happen or if they see it's growing organically get in there and try and you know move it a little bit off to the side and get it to go trying to or fill

(58:09) it up with infiltrators and collapse the whole thing from the inside. But but this is this is one of those things. I mean so much of what is sold to us as just cultural change is really being done by Tavistock Institute by the mainstream corporate media by Madison Avenue's advertising uh power and by the Rockefellers and and moneyed interests that that have a that want you that want

society to act and and behave in a certain way and they have the money and influence in order to do it.

(58:41) I mean the Rockefellers controlled the United Nations and the United Nations was one of the most powerful groups um operating today. So >> So quick a quick question uh going back to the Wasp group. I know you touched on like Saturn and the Sabatian Frankst element as part of that other cohort. But for the for the Wasp group, what what do they worship? Do they worship ball as some people say? you know, is it druidic things that I hear people talk about? What do what I'm just curious what is driving them? What you know, they're these are the ones

(59:17) that go to Bohemian Grove, you know, these are the ones that are I mean, they're in they're into similar things, you know, they're into um they're into harming children ritually. They're into um sacrifices, things like that. It's dark. Yeah. At the highest levels, of course. I mean, again, I don't want people to think that like everybody that's even slightly related to these people is is down in some underground cave, you know, drinking adrenochrome.

There's a lot of uh power plants and oil refineries and ports that are going coming offline and they don't get turned on quickly. [clears throat] They don't get this doesn't happen overnight. This takes years, decades maybe even.

(1:02:03) So, we're going to be into uh a place where there's going to be uh severe energy issues, maybe even supply chain issues with regard to fertilizers, ura, nitrogen, things like that. And this is what Michael Yan is calling the

gigaf famine, right? He's been on about the giga famine for for quite a while. I think he's right.

(1:02:22) I think this this is this is shaping up. I'm I'm starting to see these pieces sort of come out of, you know, come out and just start glowing here. and um take this much energy out of the equation this quickly and it's hard to replace it and I think things are going to look differently. So I fear for the famine outcomes in places like South Asia, you know, the the ones that are on this list, Pakistan, India, Bangladesh, they're all in the 13 countries.

(1:02:55) >> The global south, basically the global south. >> Y they're going to get hit hard. Africa is going to get hit hard. Uh so but again, all part of the plan, not a not a problem. This for them, this is what they want. You know, this works. This works well for them. Um so, you know, that that's that's kind of that's where I I'm if I was to say I have one big fear out of all this is that I is I know that they're trying to depopulate. I get that.

(1:03:27) That hasn't changed. that's been going on for hundreds of years. But my fear is that now, right now, specifically now, with what's happening in the Middle East and what's happening in Russia and Ukraine and German Nordstream pipeline and, you know, the the Saudi East West pipeline that just got knocked out. And this is the G20 bank bailin basically just said like instead of a bailout which is like the government is going to come and bail out your bank give give them money from outside the bank bailin says this bank is going to be insolvent let's say let's say that calculations been made it's

(1:05:20) going to be insolvent and the only way we can make it not insolvent is to take the depositor's money convert it to equity and then have us reassessed and then they'll say okay your bank is not insolvent, but we've stolen all your money and you be because you're an unsecured creditor in your own bank account, third position behind the shareholders and the bond holders.

(1:05:42) And on top of that, we've now done the bank bailin legislation which allowed us to legally steal it. So, they're going to steal it. They're going to do it. This is going to happen 100%. They wouldn't have legalized it if they

weren't going to do it. The only question is when is it going to happen? And so when Ursula Vanderladen starts talking about this recently and and people go this is it this is it.

(1:06:04) This is what they're doing. So so for those of you in the EU in the five countries that are part of this uh which are um it UK, Italy, France, Germany and Turkey. You better get your money out of the bank. And you don't want to wait because they're going to steal it. Just tell >> where where should they I know you kind of touched on it. (1:06:33) Could you get a little granular with where you suggest they direct it? I mean metals. >> Oh, I mean I Well, I'll say I'm not licensed to give financial advice. I'll start by saying that. But I personally I would be >> quite literally anything is better than keeping it in the bank account if they're going to steal it. >> Turn it into anything else.

(1:06:56) bullets, uh, under your mattress, gold, silver, Bitcoin, Monero, uh, productive farmland, uh, you know, whatever you think, whatever has value is has got to be better than that. Now, if you've got a lot of money in there, like you need to be strategic about it, obviously, like, but but just just know just know that they would not have taken the extraordinary step of legalizing the stealing of your money out of your bank account unless they intended to do it.

(1:07:28) And these people, I mean, you they're they're not only are they politicians, they're also bankers. Does it get any worse than that? Can you think of a bigger scumbag than a politician banker? like they're lying, grifting by default. Don't trust them at all. And you're going to keep your money with them in their bank.

(1:07:48) She wants the EU to be in charge of taking the money out of the bank accounts of the people in in under their control and using it to invest in European companies. Well, why isn't anybody else investing in European companies? Because they're under so much regulation from the EU that you can't make any money. So they're forcing you to invest in shitty deals in Europe and you're they're going to lose all your money because they're because imagine trusting your life savings to the EU to Ursula Vanderladen.

(1:08:58) So, it pays to be knowledgeable about where these lunatic uh bankers want to take you because if it's up to them, they'll steal all your money. This is pure speculation on my part, but given a pattern, my my pattern of noticing things, before they do something like that, they will run a massive purge on everybody's YouTubes and social media accounts to get rid of anybody who would be critical of this.

(1:10:10) They'll knock everybody out first. >> Yes. So before you see a a a conscription or a draft into the military, you will see a massive purge of anybody who would be critical of it first. >> That I can guarantee. Just like >> I don't know whether or not they'll do it. If they do do it, then they'll do that.

(1:10:30) And and I would defer to >> Michael Yawn uh on that. If he says he's got he's got good numbers on it, I would defer to him. (1:39:39) Here's um here's Alexander King and Bertren Schneider, inventors of global warming, founders of the Club of Rome. This is in their book in 1991, the first global revolution.
